

Job Description, Water and Wastewater Operator

Winelco Inc., based out of Cincinnati Ohio, provides contract operation for privately owned water and wastewater treatment plants from 2,000 to 200,000 gallons per day. We are seeking a full time candidate with a background in environmental sciences / environmental engineering to operate, maintain, and repair and potentially design these systems. For the right individual, this position offers potential for advancement into consulting, design, and or management within the company.

The operator's work is generally outdoors although there is often considerable driving time to reach the sites. Several sites are visited each day by the operator. Time is also spent in the office / shop filing EPA reports, performing repairs, conducting laboratory work or purchasing and fabricating equipment. There is also considerable interaction with various treatment plant owners, maintenance personnel, and regulatory agencies.

The water / wastewater operator may perform the following tasks:

- Control and monitor the biological treatment process
- Operate pumps, motors, blowers
- Monitor flow meters
- Perform routine servicing and cleaning of plant, pipes, and equipment
- Clean sand filters
- Monitor, operate, and troubleshoot electrical controls
- Take samples for analysis
- Perform laboratory analyses
- Prepare reports and logs detailing plant operation

- Willing to get dirty when necessary
